What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files (letters and numbers) that are stored by your browser, if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your device's drive. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to us about the people who use our website, www.gendercollab.in.

How do we use them?

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website and to provide you with a good experience when you browse it.

What types of Cookies do we use?

- Non necessary (analytics/performance/advertisement cookies): these cookies may not be
 necessary for the website to function, but are used specifically to collect user-personal data
 via analytics and embedded content. We use Google Analytics to track user analytics: you
 can view <u>details on Google Analytics' use of data here</u>. Some cookies are additionally set
 by YouTube embeds on the website. You may decline to accept these cookies, though this
 may affect some website functionality.
- **Necessary Cookies:** Necessary cookies are absolutely essential for the website to function properly. This category only includes cookies that ensure basic functionality and security features of the website. These cookies do not store any personal information.

We use the following cookies:

Authentication	One Month	Set by the website to store authenticated session for logged in users.	Wordpress Login

You will need to accept or decline the cookies we use.

To enrich our content, we may embed video content from websites such as YouTube, and audio content from sites such as Soundcloud. As a result, when you view content embedded from these sites, they may set a cookie.

The website carries embedded 'share' buttons to enable users of the site to easily share articles with their friends through a number of popular social networks, for example, Facebook, Twitter, or LinkedIn. These sites may set a cookie when you are also logged in to their service OPM does not control the dissemination of these cookies and you should check the relevant third-party website for more information about these.

How do I change my cookie settings?

When you visit the website, you will see a dialogue/popup box, which will have the required buttons/switches for you to manage the cookies the website saves on your device.

You can also block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. Most web browsers allow some control of most cookies through the browser settings. The Help function within your browser should tell you how to do this. Alternatively, you may wish to visit <u>www.aboutcookies.org</u> which contains comprehensive information on how to do this on a wide variety of browsers. You will also find details on how to delete cookies from your device as well as more general information about cookies. For information on how to do this on the browser of your device, you may need to refer to your device help.

Please be aware that restricting cookies may impact on the functionality and your experience of websites.
